The product assessment was based on BS EN 149:2001, the English language version of EN 149:2001 respiratory protective devices, filtering half masks to protect against particles.

PRODUCT DETAILS:

The five models within the Q2002 range are single shift masks to protect against solid and non-volatile liquid particles. The masks are of the fold flat type with a covered metal nose bridge and elasticated head straps. The range covers the three filtering classifications of EN 149. Two models within the range are available either with or without exhalation valves whilst the other model is only available with an exhalation valve.
